





How to Write a Position Paper?

The following document shall articulate the country's position and current scenario concerning the designated topic, adhering to an essay structure and a two-page length constraint, exclusive of references.

General Guidelines

1. Background of the Problem:

Write a brief introduction that includes the history of your country regarding the problems of your delegation and committee, and how the problem or topic affects your country. If there are any policies that your country has toward this issue and the context of these policies to be created.

2. Past International Actions:

Write about the conventions and resolutions in which the country has participated to solve the conflict as well as the United Nations actions that the country has supported or, if not, has opposed. Mention if the country's government has taken any action to reduce the impact of the conflict and statistics that support the country's position on the issue.

3. Possible Solutions:

Write about the ideas/proposals that the country believes can be implemented to address the issue and what the country would like to achieve within the resolution elaborated with the rest of the nations. Indicate how the position of other countries affects your country's position.
